

# Elections in 3 french political parties

Let's start with party that finished 4th in the 2017 presidential elections, according to ex-journalists from Sud Ouest on Agoravox TV. It's Solidarity and Progress. The Solidarity and Progress office is elected each year in September during the association's general assembly.

Let's continue with the political parties that are in minority in 2025 but were popular until the presidency of François Hollande. The Socialist Party has along used paper ballots for its elections. These were the most regular elections of all political parties. Televised debates had been organized for Ségolène Royal's election, who had really received militants' approval in 2006. But Ségolène Royal should have been elected national secretary of socialist party in 2007. Indeed, every socialist party's leaders asked to cheat in their stronghold to elect Martine Aubry, who was an outsider but appreciated by media after Delanoé, a liberal.
